


The Cloud Still a Contentious Issue

While it is assumed that by now the question of "should we use a Cloud provider?" has been pretty much settled, it is estimated that as many as 40% of business and institutional telecom systems are still premises based. There are managers who have yet to confront this critical issue.

Many of the original fears about the Cloud have been dispelled through actual experiences. Those who now embrace a new Cloud solution will hardly be trail blazers.

- Better security than a premises-based alternative

While this may imply that the only practical approach is to use the Cloud, there are high quality full featured premises-based systems that are still available, albeit fewer than in the past. Manufactures have been discontinuing their premises products, so for those favoring an on-site system, the choices are limited.
